Mr. Jackson requests that the Court issue an order that the hearing on the District Attorney's "Motion for Order Allowing Use of Expert Testimony on the Subject of Child Abuse Trauma" be continued and for such other such further relief as the Court may deem just and proper. This request is based on the fact that the failure to continue the hearing would deprive Mr. Jackson of his right to a fair trial, due process of law, equal protection, privileges and immunities and effective assistance of counsel within the meaning of the Fourth, Fifth, Sixth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and the corresponding rights under the California Constitution. 
