DECLARATION OF GERALD McC. FRANKLIN

I, Gerald McC. Franklin, say:

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Ιó

I am a lawyer admitted to practice in the State of California. I am a deputy of the District Attorney of Santa Barbara County, and I am co-counsel with the District Attorney in the prosecution of this matter.

Certain property was seized in the name of the People of the State of California on November 18, 2003 from the office of Bradley Miller at 211 South Beverly Drive, Suite 108, Beverly Hills, California in obedience to search warrant bearing number SW 8844686. At the time of the search of Mr. Miller's office, Daniel Nixon, an attorney, orally asserted the "lawyer-client" and "work-product" privileges as to the property in that office. The above-described property is presently in the custody of the Sheriff of Santa Barbara County and it has not been examined by investigating officers.

On Friday, January 16, 2004, following defendant's arraignment and the calendaring of further hearings on February 13, 2004, I submitted "PLAINTIFF'S REQUEST FOR ORDER DIRECTING THE SHERIFF TO LODGE CERTAIN ITEMS OF PROPERTY SEIZED IN OBEDIENCE TO WARRANT FOR SEARCH OF BRADLEY MILLER'S OFFICE" and a proposed "ORDER THEREON" to the clerk of the court for the court's review and approval on Tuesday, January 20, 2004. Attached as an exhibit to the Request is a copy of one page of the Sheriff's Department's "Santa Barbara County Property Form" in Sheriff's Case No. 03-5670 that I redacted at the suggestion of *****. I served a copy of that Request on counsel for Defendant and Mr. Miller by facsimile transmission.

Late Friday afternoon my office received a facsimile copy of a letter to me from Daniel Nixon, Mr. Miller's counsel, expressing his concern that the redacted version of the property form was insufficiently redacted to avoid disclosure of information such as the complainant's name and a description of where certain property was located in Mr. Miller's office. He earnestly suggested that "a better job of redacting the property form is needed."

In a telephone conversation with Mr. Geragos on Saturday, he suggested that Plaintiff's Request, together with its exhibit, be filed under seal.

This followup request is intended to accomplish the sealing of Plaintiff's Request and its attachment.

I declare that the foregoing is true. I execute this Declaration under penalty of perjury at Santa Barbara, California on January 20, 2004.

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ORDER

The Court has read and considered Plaintiff's Request for Sealing of its REQUEST FOR ORDER DIRECTING THE SHERIFF TO LODGE CERTAIN ITEMS OF PROPERTY SEIZED IN OBEDIENCE TO WARRANT FOR SEARCH OF BRADLEY MILLER'S OFFICE and the supporting Declaration of Gerald McC. Franklin.

The Court expressly finds that:

- 1. There exists an overriding interest in the parties' right to a fair trial that overcomes the right of public access to the records concerning the searches made of the defendant's property and the property of individuals employed by him;
- Certain property may be subject to a claim of lawyer-client privilege or the work product privilege, and if it is found to be privileged, disclosure of its contents to the public will be prohibited;
 - 3. The overriding interest supports sealing the record;
- 4. A reasonable probability exists that the overriding interest will be prejudiced if the documents in question are not sealed;
 - 5. The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and
 - 6. No less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding interest.

It is therefore ordered that the Clerk of the Court of the Santa Barbara County Superior Court seal the said REQUEST FOR ORDER and its attached exhibit and that the document be kept in the custody of the Superior Court Clerk's Office and not be made part of the public record until further order of the Court.
