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Bashir "documentary" "Living with Michael Jackson" (hereinafter Bashir tape) into evidence. Mr. Jackson objects to the admission of a tape of the Bashir tape on the grounds that: (1) the tape contains hearsay; (2) the tape is not relevant evidence because it is heavily edited in the most sensational fashion possible: (3) the tape contains commentary of celebrity "journalists" opining on issues like Mr. Jackson's guilt; (4) the tape contains highly inflammatory and irrelevant material regarding matters such as Mr. Jackson's care of his own children, plastic surgery, Mr. Jackson's financial affairs, and other prejudicial matters. The admission of the Bashir tape threatens to deprive Mr. Jackson of his federal and state constitutional rights to a fair trial, due process of law, and right to a reliable verdict and sentence pursuant to the Fifth, Sixth, Eighth, and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and Article 1, Sections 7, 15, 17 and 24 of the California Constitution.

## **ARGUMENT**

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## MR. JACKSON OBJECTS TO THE ADMISSION OF THE BASHIR TAPE BECAUSE IT CONTAINS HEARSAY AND IS IRRELEVANT

The Bashir tape contains much more than statements of a party. The tape presents Mr. Jackson in a sensational fashion that is designed to attract television viewers by exploiting Mr. Jackson. Both Martin Bashir and Barbara Walters make unflattering comments about Mr. Jackson throughout the tape. These comments touch upon issues such as his care for his children, plastic surgery, his finances, and allegations of the sexual abuse of children. All of these statements constitute hearsay.

The tape is theatrical and includes elements such as dubbed in music, that becomes more frenetic and more ominous as the program progresses. It is heavily edited to portray Mr. Jackson in a light that is designed to attract viewers, not to present truth. Hollywood techniques were used to make the video more dramatic. Scenes are juxtaposed. The pace of the program is edited to build drama. It is not the kind of reliable evidence that should be presented to a jury.

OPPOSITION TO DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S MOTION FOR ADMISSION OF MARTIN BASHIR'S "DOCUMENTARY" "LIVING WITH MICHAEL JACKSON"

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The prosecution's proposed jury instructions are woefully inadequate in terms of unringing the bell. Playing a slickly produced Hollywood hit piece for the jurors, and then asking them to consider the tape for the "limited purpose of providing evidence of the alleged context of any action the defendant and the alleged co-conspirators may allegedly have taken" is ridiculous.

The prosecution's argument is essentially that the more prejudicial the tape is, in terms of damaging the viewer's impression of Michael Jackson, the more relevant it is to the alleged conspiracy charges. This argument is nothing more than an attempt to put inflammatory and irrelevant evidence in front of the jury under the guise of showing motive.

To allow the video at all would be unfair if we were not allowed to play portions that were deleted. Portions that were deleted were not made available to the defense because Granada Television has refused to turn them over.

For the above stated reasons, Mr. Jackson objects to the introduction of the Bashir tape.


