The court has reviewed the proposals for modification of the Protective Order, which were submitted by the parties on Tuesday, January 20, 2004. Neither proposal appears to be satisfactory. The suggestion by the prosecution is unacceptably cumbersome, and the suggestion by the defense is unacceptably broad.

The court remains interested in the concept advanced of permitting public statements to be made for the purpose of helping to quell unfounded rumors that may circulate with regard to the case, and invites the parties to reconsider their proposals and submit them for consideration at the February 13, 2004 hearing already scheduled.

In the interim, if either side perceives a need to make a statement contrary to the provisions of the present Protective Order, the specific need may be addressed by ex-parte application to the court via conference call, including opposing counsel, or in writing in accordance with the usual rules.
