I, Gerald McC. Franklin, say:

2. Plaintiff's Response to Defendant's In Limine Motion to Preclude Reference To His Collection of Sexually Explicit Materials As "Pornography," filed contemporaneously with this Request, is made on the ground that the Response makes reference to evidentiary facts not yet made public.

- 3. I believe that the interest of each party to a fair trial overrides the public's prompt access to Plaintiff's Response until the appropriateness of the release of a redacted version of the Response is determined by the Court.
- 4. I believe an order maintaining our Plaintiff's Response to Defendant's In Limine Motion to Preclude Reference To His Collection of Sexually Explicit Materials As "Pornography" under seal in the interim would avert the probability of prejudice, and that no more narrowly tailored order with respect to that pleading could be drafted to achieve the overriding interest in a fair trial.

## MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

The procedure for sealing records under California Rules of Court, rule 243.1 et seq. applies only to records that are deemed public. (Id., rule 243.1(a)(2).) Motions and responsive pleadings in criminal cases are, ordinarily, "public" records of the court.

Rule 243.1(d) provides that

The court may order that a record be filed under seal only if it expressly finds facts that establish:

- (1) There exists an overriding interest that overcomes the right of public access to the record;
  - (2) The overriding interest supports sealing the record;
- (3) A substantial probability exists that the overriding interest will be prejudiced if the record is not sealed;
  - (4) The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and
- (5) No less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding interest.

Rule 243.1(e) provides. in pertinent part:

(1) An order scaling the record must (i) specifically set forth the facts findings that support the findings and (ii) direct the scaling of only those documents and pages, or, if reasonably practicable, portions of those documents and pages, that contain the material that needs to be placed under seal. All other portions of each documents or page must be included in the public file.

Rule 243.2(b) provides, in pertinent part, that "Pending the determination of the motion [of a party to file a record under seal], the lodged record will be conditionally under seal."
