Attorney Boutrous addressed the Court re: the Emergency Motion of Certain Non-Party News Organizations to Modify Order Filed January 31, 2005 re: Jury Venire. Attorney Boutrous advised the Court that the Court's modified decorum order that was previously released addressed all the most immediate concerns.
