THE COURT HAS THE AUTHORITY TO ORDER THAT
A RECORD BE FILED UNDER SEAL

Pursuant to California Rule of Court 243.1(d), the Court has the authority to order a record be filed under seal if it expressly finds that:

- 1. There exists an overriding interest that overcomes the right of public access to the record;
  - 2. The overriding interest supports sealing the record;
- 3. A substantial probability exists that the overriding interest will be prejudiced if the record is not sealed;
  - 4. The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and
- 5. No less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding interest. (California Rule of Court 243.1(d).)

## OVERRIDING INTEREST EXIST THAT MEETS THE ABOVE CRITIRIA FOR SEALING A RECORD

Movant makes this request to protect its privacy and Fourth Amendment interests, and pursuant to its duties and obligations to the defendant, Michael Joe Jackson, and in that capacity invokes as further support for the request the overriding interest of Mr. Jackson's rights to due process and a fair trial under the Fifth, Sixth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and Article I, Sections 1, 7, and 15 of the California Constitution.

An inspection of the motion and exhibit will reveal possible evidence, the

admissibility of which, is yet to be determined.

The overriding interests of Mr. Jackson's rights to a fair trial and due process would be compromised if the motion and exhibit are not filed under seal. A person accused of a crime is entitled to due process and a fair trial under the Fifth, Sixth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and Article I, Sections 1, 7, and 15 of the California Constitution. Material referenced in the motion and exhibit if made public, would compromise Mr. Jackson's these rights and would result in prejudice to Mr. Jackson. In order to protect these overriding interests, it is necessary that the exhibits be filed under seal. Moreover, until a judicial determination has been made as to the validity of the subpoena, Movant's privacy and Fourth Amendment interests outweigh any public interest in disclosure of the matters that would be revealed.

## CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above, Movant requests that the Court issue an order that NOTICE OF MOTION AND MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM and accompanying documents be filed under seal.
