1 I do hereby certify as follows:

2 1. The above-entitled criminal prosecution against defendant Michael Joe
3 Jackson ("Mr. Jackson") is now pending in the Superior Court of the State of California for
4 the County of Santa Barbara. Mr. Jackson is charged with one count of conspiracy to
5 commit false imprisonment, child abduction and extortion (Count 1); four counts of lewd
6 conduct upon a child (Counts 2, 3, 4 and 5); one count of attempt to commit a lewd act
7 upon a child (Count 6); and four counts of administering alcohol to a minor to assist in
8 commission of a felony (Counts 7, 8, 9 and 10).

9 2. Mr. Jackson has entered a plea of not guilty to all charges. Trial began on
10 February 28, 2005.

11 3. David LeGrand, Esq., whose business address is Marquis & Aurbach, 10001
12 Park Run Drive, Las Vegas, Nevada 89145, is a material witness for Mr. Jackson in this
13 case because he would testify to the issue of Mr. Jackson's innocence to the charged
14 crimes, particularly the alleged conspiratorial acts. Mr. LeGrand is intimately familiar
15 with Mr. Jackson's business affairs and the activities of the alleged unindicted co-
16 conspirators during the relevant time period. As Mr. Jackson's lawyer, Mr. LeGrand
17 participated in the significant events surrounding the Bashir documentary and is familiar
18 with the activities of various Prosecution's witnesses.

19 4. The presence of this witness is required for approximately 2 to 4 court days,
20 commencing sometime between May 11, 2005 and May 20, 2005 (subject to an on-call
21 agreement with the defense), in Department SM-2 of the above-entitled court, located at
22 312-C East Cook Street, Santa Maria, CA 93456-5369.

23 5. The laws of California afford the witness protection from arrest and service
24 of civil and criminal process during the time he is in California in obedience to the
25 subpoena directing him to appear and testify in this state, with respect to any matter
26 occurring before the witness' entrance into California under the subpoena.


27 6. This Certificate is made for the purpose of being presented to a Judge of a
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court of record in the State of Nevada. The Judge in Nevada may conduct a hearing and make an order directing Mr. David LeGrand to appear as a witness at the trial of the above-entitled matter commencing sometime between May 11, 2005 and May 20, 2005 (subject to an on-call agreement with the defense), until his testimony is completed, including, if necessary, the fifth court day of his testimony, in Department SM-2 of the Superior Court of the State of California for the County of Santa Barbara, located at 312-C East Cook Street, Santa Maria, CA 93456-5369.

7. Pursuant to California Penal Code Section 1334.3, Mr. LeGrand, at the time the trial subpoena is served on him, shall be tendered the sum of ten cents (\$ 0.10) for each mile necessarily traveled (if he elects surface travel) or the minimum round trip scheduled airlines fare plus twenty cents (\$ 0.20) a mile for necessary surface travel at either end of the flight if the witness elects air travel, and except as provided in subdivision (b) of Penal Code Section 1334.3, a per diem of twenty dollars (\$ 20) for each day that he is required to travel and attend as a witness. Further, Mr. LeGrand shall be reimbursed for any additional expenses which this Court finds reasonable and necessary.
