PLAINTIFF'S REQUEST FOR ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE RE: CONTEMPT OF COURT'S PROTECTIVE ORDER BY PERSONS SUBJECT TO THAT ORDER; DECLARATION OF THOMAS W. SNEDDON, JR.

INTRODUCTION

On January 23, 2004 the court issued a protective order in the above-captioned case. Prior to the issuance of this order, Russell Halpern Esq., the attorney for David Arvizo, the victim's father, had become a public figure in this case by making more than ten appearances on a variety of local and nationally-televised news shows including *The Today Show*, *The Abrams Report* and *The O'Reilly Factor*. The subject of Mr. Halpern's appearances and the interest the media has shown in broadcasting his remarks have been focused upon one thing – attacking the victim's credibility by vilifying the victim's mother with assertions that she is manipulating her children to make false allegations against the defendant. Mr. Halpern's nationally televised condemnation not only asserted that the victim's mother is unfit, manipulative and a liar, but also included his numerous attempts to vouch for the character

and credibility of the defendant. (See Exhibit A, attached – DVD Video News Clips with Transcripts of Halpern Interviews before 1/23/04.)

A review of video clips of Mr. Halpern's statements makes plain his newfound celebrity is dependent solely upon the fact that he represents the father of Michael Jackson's accuser. It is also obvious that without this circumstance, the media would have no interest in Mr. Halpern or what he has to say about this case. The court must now evaluate more recent remarks made to the press by Mr. Halpern and his client in light of Mr. Halpern's past demagoguery about the credibility of the victim and the victim's mother

## RUSSELL HALPERN AND HIS CLIENT, DAVID ARVIZO ARE IN DIRECT VIOLATION OF THE COURT'S PROTECTIVE ORDER

On January 27 2004 the District Attorney notified Russell Halpern by letter and facsimile that he and his client, David Arvizo, are potential witnesses in this case and that they are therefore subject to the court's protective order. (See Exhibit B, attached – Letter and FAX to Russell Halpern from Thomas W. Sneddon, Jr.) A short time after this letter was delivered the District Attorney spoke with Mr. Halpern by telephone and specifically reiterated the contents of the letter. Mr. Sneddon cautioned Mr. Halpern about future contacts with the media and the gravity of any deviation from the court's order. (See Attached Declaration of Thomas W. Sneddon, Jr.)

In defiance of the court's order, Mr. Halpern then appeared on three national news programs and made comments to the media dealing with evidence directly related to this case:

February 7, 2004
FOX NEWS (FNC)
Big Story Weekend Edition
(See Exhibit C, attached – DVD and Transcript)

On February 7, 2004, Russell Halpern appeared on the nationally televised Fox News

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- Big Story Weekend Edition program and made remarks concerning his lack of personal knowledge regarding the facts of this case. During this interview, Mr. Halpern expressed his hostility toward the court's order by ascribing "disingenuous" motives to Santa Barbara District Attorney Tom Sneddon in asking for the order. Finally, Mr. Halpern purposely attacked the credibility of a material witness in this case - the victim's mother - by asserting that she suffered from serious mental disorders and claiming she has been treated in a mental hospital.

It is worth noting that Mr. Halpern had previously been publicly berated for making similar remarks on the January 14, 2004 edition of the syndicated radio talk show, The John and Ken Show. (See attached Exhibit D - audio cassette tape and transcript.) During this show Mr. Halpern, who was a call-in guest, admitted that he did not really "know" whether or not his allegations that the victim's mother was in a mental hospital were true. If Mr. Halpern suffered any illusions about the effect such remarks had upon the credibility of witnesses in this case, he was unequivocally disabused of those notions by these two outspoken radio show hosts.

Mr. Halpern's statements made on February 7, 2004 are in direct violation of the court's order that witnesses not "comment upon the weight, value, or effect of any evidence as tending to establish guilt or innocence."

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February 9, 2004 The Early Show

**CBS News**

On February 9, 2004, Russell Halpern appeared on nationally-televised The Early Show. The People are not yet in possession of video or audio for this appearance, however, 24 25 the following quote from Mr. Halpern's interview is published on the official website for CBS News and the Associated Press Newswire:

> "From what I understand, Mr. Jackson was a very hospitable and very good host and never displayed any conduct that would cause anybody any concern."

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This statement, vouching for Mr. Jackson's character and innocence is in direct violation of the court's order that witnesses not "comment upon the weight, value, or effect of any evidence as tending to establish guilt or innocence."

February 13, 2004 *Larry King Live* 

Cable News Network

(See Exhibit F, attached – DVD and Transcript)

On February 13, 2004, Russell Halpern and his client, David Arvizo, appeared on nationally-televised Larry King Live. During this interview, Mr. Halpern and Mr. Arvizo talked about Mr. Arvizo's pending visitation and child custody litigation with the victim's mother. Both Mr. Halpern and Mr. Arvizo also discussed prior criminal convictions suffered by Mr. Arvizo for spousal abuse involving the victim's mother and child abuse involving one of the victim's siblings. Both Mr. Halpern and Mr. Arvizo asserted that the accusations made by the victim's mother that led to these convictions were false. In addition, Mr. Arvizo vouched for the defendant when he expressed that defendant has always been a "real good friend." Mr. Arvizo then expressed his personal doubts about whether the victim in this case has ever even made an accusation of sexual misconduct against the defendant.

These remarks deal with the credibility of material witnesses in the present case and are in direct violation of the court's explicit order not to divulge "extrajudicial statements of witnesses" or to "comment upon the weight, value, or effect of any evidence as tending to establish guilt or innocence."

#### CONCLUSION

Prior to January 23, 2004, Mr. Halpern's affinity for television cameras could only be described as opportunistic pandering to the media. Now, Mr. Halpern's public performances, both alone and with his client at his side, have become contemptible. Even while acknowledging the court's directive, he has continued to attack the credibility of material witnesses and comment on extrajudicial statements made by them. The People respectfully

request that the court issue an order to Russell Halpern and his client, David Arvizo, directing them to show cause why each of them should not be held in contempt. Should the court agree with the People's request, individual orders to show cause for Russell Halpern and David Arvizo with a hearing date scheduled for the next calendared appearance date of April 2, 2004, are attached.

Halpern also said the couple went through some (sic) very bad divorce a few of years ago and that the mother made charges of abuse against the father ... that were later found to be false.

TV: As the self proclaimed king of pop faces charges of child molestation the attorney for the father is speaking out.... RUSSELL HALPERN is a criminal defense lawyer in California representing the boy's father. Mr. Halpern good morning to you.

TV: Let me begin. I think we need to make this clear - your client does not have custody of his children, and in fact he hasn't seen his son in some months but he is blaming [ahh] the boy's mother for the alleged incident, is that correct?

He's upset by the charges, he's upset by things he learned about his son spending the evening with an adult male without supervision. But as far as blaming his wife, ahh he hasn't said that at all.

RH: Well, [Lynn] my client had contact with MICHAEL JACKSON a few years ago. He considered MICHAEL JACKSON a family friend and he was ahh happy with the relationship. TV: Does he think that his son is lying – He says that he was molested – ahh – the father says he doesn't really know, Does he think his son is making this up? What would lead him to think the son was creating this?

RH: Well, he has not expressed an opinion to one way of the other as to Whether his son is lying or not – he has expressed – and <u>I also have formed the opinion that his wife or exwife better said</u>, has the capability and potential to do such a thing. Not that she did it but that she demonstrated in the past – that she is capable of ..... her children.

also some accusations of child abuse, he had told me and other people had told me that she had made these ahh stories up and she was very controlling of her children. I asked him for some proof of that and he brought to me scripts that she had prepared for the kids when they had a civil suit a year or so earlier in which she had actually written out for about four or five pages questions and answers and I was told that she spent hours prompting the children on how to answer questions. RH: No, its not - he, my client has suffered for the last 3 years - She had falsely accused him of assaulting her - and also encouraged one of her children to make up another story that he had threatened to kill her -- That was in court for about 6 months and during that time it was determined that the threats were false and that there was indication that the mother had made that up - Right now my client just wishes to crawl into a hole and not be bothered by any of this and I ---

TV: Let me just ask you about one other situation – I think defense counsel might be interested in – Mark Geragos – apparently there was a report on the Daily News – the New York Daily News – that the boy had been....umm. coached by his father to shoplift and had been caught in a parking lot with his parents.

A big bust up with the security guards...What was all that about?

RH: Well, to begin with, that's the first time I heard that the father had been accused of coaching the son to shoplift — I think what the truth of that is — that the mother and I don't know if the boy was with her — but some of her children were with her — when she was stopped and accused of shoplifting by security guards and then she claimed that they assaulted her. She sued the store guards in the store and what that was about is that later when I was preparing for his defense, we were given a ahh, memo that she had written where she had dictated to her children what they should say — when they were questioned by the attorneys in a deposition. She actually wrote out the questions and answers. We got that in order to show that she has control over her kids and that she can — uhh, get them to say things that she wants them to say.

TV: So why would the father defend J, Well, if you read through literally stacks of documents – that detail years of battling between the father and his now ex-wife, you get some insight into this family. There was a bankruptcy, a lawsuit over a shoplifting arrest, the boy, the alleged thief – settled for 6 figures – A divorce, custody and child support fight – and criminal charges against the father — the wife accusing him of abusing her and their 3 kids. He pled no contest to one count — still insists it was untrue …

And now, the father's attorney says the dad thinks the J case might be another example of his exwife's alleged manipulation. In one court document it says he blames most of his family's problems on his wife's mental condition.

TV: Santa Barbara District Attorney Tom Sneddon won't say how much of this background he was aware of before arresting Jackson, but he has said he has a credible, cooperative witness. As for the father of the accuser – attorney H says the dad never dreamed he'd be caught up in a super star scandal - he's just trying to see his 3 kids – which now by court order he cannot --- until he completes parenting classes.

TV: Now the attorney for the father was in court today for a progress report on those parenting classes. The father was not there, he has stayed out of sight since the J allegations broke as has the boy's mother and we are choosing not to name them [....] because we haven't named the young boy either.

RH: Well I don't know if my client has ever actually heard that quote — when I heard it now and about an hour ago it reminded me of my own daughters — who are now both grown — and I asked them today — you still hate me? because that is somewhat common to hate their parents from time to time so I don't know in what context that was said ... my client - I don't know if he even heard it.

But I have spoken to my client about his relationship to his son – he said that he was very close to his son and that his son had at times, when he was with the mother and separated from my client, he would ..... wish he could come back and live with the father that he did not like living with the mother.

TV: Finally sir, we have had all manner of updates on the health of your client's son from the owner of a comedy store in southern California --- What do you know about how well the boy is right now?

RH: OK, I cannot tell you what my source is, but I can tell you that I have a very reliable source from a individual who would know and have reason to know about the health of the young man. And that source has told me that the young man, his condition has not changed from 6 months ago. He is not near death, he is not in need of any kidney transplant that he is as healthy as he was 6 months ago and I am sure that source is probably referring to the time that he was seen on television with MICHAEL JACKSON -- And so these reports from this person who owns the comedy factory --- I don't know where he got his information. My source says that he spoke with MICHAEL JACKSON, excuse me, the young man yesterday – and said that he appeared to be fine and there was no reason to worry.

TV: That was Keith O... last night and coming up tonight – He's fighting for the kind of pop while defending Scott Peterson as well – Is super lawyer Mark Geragos stretched to thin to give both men the best defense??

TV: Now the latest on the MICHAEL JACKSON case.....CBS news has learned that as the controversy mushroomed, the entertainer hired his own investigators to interview the boy who

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alleged he was molested and to interview his family. Now the boy's father is demanding to see LA County Child Welfare records which claim the sex abuse charges were unfounded.

CBS News 2 has all the latest....

J, very much aware of the CS investigation back in February. It is during this time he hires Mark Geragos as his attorney and had his investigator interview the family. TV: You could not have this any better for the defense than that – I mean this is exactly what you're going to be saying about a young witness that they're easily manipulated into saying things that a parent wants...

COMMENTATOR TV2: Life happens, and we don't take any of our victims or witnesses from central casting – we take them as we find them – the fact that there may be a spousal abuse charge or a child abuse charge or orders of protection in this family doesn't necessarily take away from the credibility of the child victim.

1. Release or authorize the release for public dissemination of any purported extrajudicial statement of either the defendant or witnesses relating to this case;

- 2. Release or authorize the release of any documents, exhibits, photographs, or any evidence, the admissibility of which may have to be determined by the Court;
- 3. Make any statement for public dissemination as to the existence or possible existence of any document, exhibit, photograph or any other evidence, the admissibility of which may have to be determined by the Court;
- 4. Express outside of court an opinion or make any comment for public dissemination as to the weight, value, or effect of any evidence as tending to establish guilt or innocence;
- 5. Make any statement outside of court as to the content, nature, substance, or effect of any statements or testimony that have been given or is expected to be given in any proceeding in or relating to this matter;
- Issue any statement as to the identity of any prospective witness, or the witness's
  probable testimony, or the effect thereof;
- 7. Make any out-of-court statement as to the nature, source, or effect of any purported evidence alleged to have been accumulated as a result of the investigation of this matter.

This Order does not include any of the following:

- Factual statements of the accused person's name, age, residence, occupation and family status.
- 2. The time and place of arrest, the identity of the arresting and investigating officers and agencies, and the length of the investigation.

TV:....We've got some more exclusive information on the Jackson case now which you'll see only here on Fox..."

People close to Jackson are telling me that the new spokesperson for Jackson, Ramon Baine (phonetic) who was hired just a few days ago and her hiring was directed by Leonard Mohammad, the security chief for the Nation of Islam who has been glued to Jackson's side for months. Publicly Baine is saying, as you heard from Geraldo, that there is no secret summit taking place in the LA area in the next few days:

But numerous sources close to Jackson tell me that she's not being candid, that a secret summit, as I first reported, will happen. That they didn't want it leaked out in the press and that several financial bigwigs tied to Jackson pushed for this meeting with Jackson and have told him that the Nation of Islam must remove itself from handling Jackson's finances or they will leave and also cannot get refinancing from the Bank of America on a massive loan that Jackson has due I'm told on around approximately February 17 for somewhere between 280 to 300 million dollars.

The Nation of Islam may still pay a security role but Jackson's long time advisors want them out of the financial sphere. Some more exclusive details --- I've learned that it was not Germaine Jackson but Randy Jackson, who spoke with Geraldo as you just heard, Jackson's youngest brother who actually brought the Nation of Islam around Michael months ago and get this, we've learned that Randy Jackson is now the only Jackson family member who is allowed

to contact to Michael. That all the other family members including Germaine and Michael's own parents have been cut off from Michael by the Nation of Islam and that the family is livid.

I'm told that it's gotten so bad that, get this, Tito, Jackie and Germaine Jackson got into a fist fight with the Nation of Islam guards in Neverland about two and a half weeks ago – who would not let them see Michael and that one of the guards threatened Tito saying quote "we could really hurt you". I'm told that Michael Jackson himself had to break up that fight.

Joining us now to talk about all of the explosive developments is attorney, Russell Halpern who represents the father of the boy accusing Michael Jackson and we also have Ken Baker of U.S. Weekly, *US Weekly* rather, reporting some new information on what was taken from Jackson's estate when it was raided.

Um, Ken, I want to talk with you ---- US Weekly – you guys have done a really good job with this story. I understand it is getting really ugly between the Nation of Islam and the family members now

Ken Baker: Ya, well, actually, um...I spoke to Mark Geragos, interviewed him about 3 days ago in Los Angeles, ah again, like Geraldo said, Mark Geragos much like Michael is very very aware of this gag order ah that won't allow them to talk to anything (sic) ...talk about anything relevant to the facts of the case. However, Mark wanted to make it very clear to me that... the Nation of Islam is not involved in any way with his legal strategy – ah they are not, as he says, they're not..

TV: What about his finances? What about taking over his finances Ken?

Ken Baker: They are not... well, you know, you know Mark's primary concern is that courtroom, dealing with the ah legal aspects of the case, ah you know...I thinks that Mark just want it taa... to be made clear that --- and its very difficult for him--- and you can see its difficult for Michael, this protective order and um, by the way Mark did tell me that he is very very eager to ah get some amendments made to this gag order because he's chomping at the bit to get back out there to talk to people like me and you... ah, to basically to be able to put down rumors and ah deny false rumors that are out there...

TV: I'm sure he is. Ah Russell, I want to bring you in ... um, we just got some visit, at least in a view of some of the court filings that were made in the case. I know you're representing the father of the accuser, the 13 year old boy who says he was molested by Michael and in court papers that we saw public this week there were some things about the mother's mental state. Tell us about that....

Russell Halpern: Well, that's been out for some time now. Basically, the papers speak for themselves. As you know, there is this gag order and I have been informed by ahh... Mr. Sneddon that he believes that I am a potential witness, which I believe is very disingenuous ... but the papers that you have.

TV: You don't believe that you would be a witness in shape or form?

Russell Halpern: Ah...of course not. I spoke to Mr. Sneddon personally and I asked him 'In what way would I be a witness' and he said, Well, maybe you could impeach certain witnesses, and then we...the conversation went on, and he, and I asked him 'Who am I going to impeach, your own witnesses?' I mean, it's ridiculous. He knows and everybody know that I have no information that is legally admissible in the case of Jackson and that's not my concern.

TV: do you believe that he is just trying to keep you quiet... is that...is that what you're saying?

Russell Halpern: Of course, of course.

TV: I know that in the court filings said that, maybe you can confirm this Russell, that it essentially just said that this mother, this is the mother of the 13 year old boy, we've heard she slapped some lawsuits, has looked for some money in the past, but now we're hearing, its been revealed that apparently she was in a mental hospital in 1998 – is that right?

Russell Halpern: That is correct. We put that in the paperwork because we believe that it's relevant in determining what is best for the children. There is no question she was in 1998 was in a mental hospital possibly suffering from severe depression and I believe possibly from bi-polar problem that she has

TV: All right, Ken, real quick, ... other things that were taking place....all these raids that were taking place around town, Mark Shafel (phonetic) former music producer...also Christian Robinson (phonetic) who was the photographer who was working with Mark Shafel. What did they get... you have some exclusive details on what they seized...

But my client and I are very concerned because as you say, we've heard conflicting things.

TV: ... and both you, thank you very much for some really interesting information we appreciate it.



(CBS/AP) The father of Michael Jackson's young accuser, who has pleaded no contest to child cruelty, said in an interview broadcast Monday that he wants a restraining order dropped so he can resume seeing his children. His attorney also says the man is not seeking money from the entertainer.

"I've been trying to get a hold of them and get in touch with them since 2001," the man said in an interview on CBS News' *The Early Show.* "I've never been without them and it's been just a world of hurt without them since I've been away from them."

Last month, a judge refused to lift a 2-year-old restraining order banning him from seeing his children. The father had requested supervised visits with the boy, his brother and sister.

The father pleaded no contest to child cruelty in 2002 and spousal abuse in 2001 and the boy's mother filed for divorce in 2001. The man's lawyer, Russell Halpern, said the father entered the no contest plea "against his own wishes," but never admitted wrongdoing.

Halpern would not let the man answer questions about the singer, citing a gag order in Jackson's case.

Jackson has pleaded innocent to seven counts of performing lewd or lascivious acts on a child under 14 and two counts of administering and intoxicating agent, reportedly wine. The singer is free on \$3 million bail pending trial.

Halpern told Early Show National Correspondent Hattle Kauffman both perents were present at Neverland.

"From what I understand, Mr. Jackson was very hospitable and a very good host and never displayed any conduct that would cause anybody any concern," he said, answering for the boy's father.

The man's son was a teenage cancer patient when the alleged abuse occurred last year.

The father described his son's illness, saying that the youth had "a 16-pound cyst in his turnmy area." The surgeon who removed the turnor said it was the "size of a football" and the boy lost a kidney, spleen and lymph nodes when the turnor was removed, the father said.

Halpern denied his client, the boy's father, is looking for money from Jackson.

"I don't foresee any lawsuit on behalf of my client," he said. "There is nothing to be discussed."

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












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
