8 office, or any materials of any kind he and/or his office has received from anyone, including
9 attorneys, witnesses, media, investigators, and any other persons or entities from outside his
10 office concerning this proceeding or Mr. Jackson.

15 by filing and serving a statement that copies of all the described materials have been provided.
