Counsel for Mr. Jackson submits the following document in response to the request of the Court for a list of items which the defense seeks to suppress as a result of the unlawful searches and seizures described in the Motion to Suppress Evidence, Part II. The following list is based on discovery provided to date by the government and is subject to revision upon being provided further discovery, upon further investigation and upon the development of additional facts during the course of the hearings on these matters. In addition, as stated in open court, it is understood that the defense has sought to suppress all intangible results of any unlawful search, including the observations of law enforcement officers and all evidence or other matters derived from the fruits of any unlawful search, including statements, leads, observations and evidence. Finally, as stated in open court, Mr. Jackson seeks to suppress all evidence whatsoever, including observations and the fruits thereof, in the event that the court grants the motion to quash the search warrants or to suppress all evidence as a result of an overbroad search.


