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MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

T.

THE COURT HAS THE AUTHORITY TO ORDER THAT A RECORD BE FILED UNDER SEAL

Pursuant to California Rule of Court 243.1(d), the Court has the authority to order a record be filed under seal if it expressly finds that:

- 1. There exists an overriding interest that overcomes the right of public access to the record;
 - 2. The overriding interest supports sealing the record;
- 3. A substantial probability exists that the overriding interest will be prejudiced if the record is not sealed;
 - 4. The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and
- 5. No less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding interest.

 (California Rule of Court 243.1(d).)

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OVERRIDING INTERESTS EXIST THAT MEETS THE ABOVE CRITERIA FOR SEALING A RECORD

It is necessary to seal the record pursuant to California Rule of Court 243.1(d) based on the overriding interests of attorney-client privilege, as well as Mr. Jackson's rights to due process and a fair trial under the Fifth, Sixth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and Article I, Sections 1, 7, and 15 of the California Constitution.

The overriding interest of attorney-client privilege justifies an order that the accompanying document be filed under seal. Confidential communications between a defendant and his or her lawyer are privileged. (California Evidence Code section 952.)

There is no right of public access to materials covered by the attorney client privilege. Mr. Jackson, as the client, is the holder of the attorney-client privilege. (California Evidence

Code section 953.) Therefore, the filing should also be in camera without service to the 1 prosecution. 2 Furthermore, Mr. Jackson's rights to a fair trial and due process would be 3 compromised if the accompanying documents are disclosed to the public. A person accused 4 of a crime is entitled to due process and a fair trial under the Fifth, Sixth and Fourteenth 5 Amendments to the United States Constitution and Article I, Sections 1, 7, and 15 of the 6 California Constitution. Furthermore, the District Attorney has requested that this document 7 be filed under seal and in camera. 8 CONCLUSION 9 For the reasons stated above, Mr. Jackson requests that the Court issue an order that 10 11 the accompanying DECLARATION OF ROBERT M.
