1 I do hereby certify as follows:

2 1. The above-entitled criminal prosecution against defendant Michael Joe
3 Jackson ("Mr. Jackson") is now pending in the Superior Court of the State of California
4 for the County of Santa Barbara. Mr. Jackson is charged with one count of conspiracy
5 to commit false imprisonment, child abduction and extortion (Count 1); four counts of
6 lewd conduct upon a child (Counts 2, 3, 4 and 5); one count of attempt to commit a lewd
7 act upon a child (Count 6); and four counts of administering alcohol to a minor to assist
8 in commission of a felony (Counts 7, 8, 9 and 10).

9 2. Mr. Jackson has entered a plea of not guilty to all charges. Trial is set to
10 begin on January 31, 2005.

11 3. Vincent Amen, whose address is [REDACTED]
12 [REDACTED] is a material witness for Mr. Jackson in this case because he can testify to the
13 issue of Mr. Jackson's innocence to the charged crimes, particularly the alleged
14 conspiratorial acts. Mr. Amen is intimately familiar with the accusers' activities and
15 the activities of various Prosecution's witnesses.

16 4. The presence of this witness is required for approximately 1 court day,
17 commencing on April 1, 2005, in Department SM-2 of the above-entitled court, located
18 at 312-C East Cook Street, Santa Maria, CA 93456-5369.

19 5. The laws of California afford the witness protection from arrest and service
20 of civil and criminal process during the time he is in California in obedience to the
21 subpoena directing him to appear and testify in this state, with respect to any matter
22 occurring before the witness' entrance into California under the subpoena.

23 6. This Certificate is made for the purpose of being presented to a Judge of a
24 court of record in the State of [REDACTED]. The Judge in [REDACTED] may conduct a
25 hearing and make an order directing Mr. Vincent Amen to appear as a witness at the
26 trial of the above-entitled matter commencing on April 1, 2005, until his testimony is
27 completed, including, if necessary, the fifth court day of his testimony, in Department

1 SM-2 of the Superior Court of the State of California for the County of Santa Barbara,
2 located at 312-C East Cook Street, Santa Maria, CA 93456-5369.

3 7. Pursuant to California Penal Code Section 1334.3, Mr. Amen, at the time
4 the trial subpoena is served on him, shall be tendered the sum of ten cents (\$ 0.10) for
5 each mile necessarily traveled (if he elects surface travel) or the minimum round trip
6 scheduled airlines fare plus twenty cents (\$ 0.20) a mile for necessary surface travel at
7 either end of the flight if the witness elects air travel, and except as provided in
8 subdivision (b) of Penal Code Section 1334.3, a per diem of twenty dollars (\$ 20) for each
9 day that he is required to travel and attend as a witness. Further, Mr. Amen shall be
10 reimbursed for any additional expenses which this Court finds reasonable and
11 necessary.
