ORDER DIRECTING THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO PRODUCE TO THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY ALL DOCUMENTS, REPORTS AND EVIDENCE CONCERNING THE ARREST AND BOOKING OF MICHAEL JOE JACKSON ON NOVEMBER 20, 2003

The Court has been informed that the California Department of Justice conducted an investigation into public allegations by defendant of mistreatment of him at the time of his arrest and booking on November 20, 2003. The Court is further informed by the Declaration of Deputy District Attorney Gerald Franklin that the Department will produce to the District Attorney all relevant documents, evidence, and reports acquired and generated in the course of that investigation if directed by this Court to do so

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the California Department of Justice (Department) produce to the District Attorney, with all reasonable promptness, all reports, photographs, tapes and documents generated or acquired in its investigation into the events and actions attending the arrest and booking on November 20, 2003 of Michael Joe Jackson, born


1 August 29, 1958, Booking No. 621785. The documents and material should include, but not
2 necessarily be limited to, reports to any law enforcement concerning the treatment of Mr.
3 Jackson during his arrest and booking, reports of interviews of percipient witnesses, including
4 sheriff's personnel, video and audio tape-recordings of interviews, events and relevant
5 locations, all lists of persons identified by or to the Department as witnesses to relevant events,
6 still photographs and motion picture footage of the relevant events, reports generated by the
7 Department and the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Department in the course of their joint or separate
8 investigations, and any findings, conclusions and final reports of the Department of Justice
9 concerning Mr. Jackson's arrest and booking and his treatment in the course thereof.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the District Attorney promptly convey to a
11 designated representative of the defense a copy of all information, reports and material
12 produced to him by the California Department of Justice in obedience to this Order.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that both the District Attorney and representatives of
14 the Defendant maintain the information and documents obtained from the Department of
15 Justice in strict confidence unless and until the Court authorizes publication or distribution of
16 some or all of the material to third parties.

17 IT IS SO ORDERED.


