- I. Gerald McC. Franklin, say:
- 1. I am a lawyer admitted to practice in the State of California. I am a Senier Deputy of the District Attorney of Santa Barbara County. I am one of the lawyers of record for the People, Plaintiff in this action.
- 2. Plaintiff's In Limine Motion to Exclude Certain Evidence Of Alleged Conduct. filed contemporaneously with this Motion to Conditionally Seal, is made on the ground that Plaintiff's In Limine Motion to Exclude Certain Evidence Of Alleged Conduct makes reference to evidentiary facts not yet made public, and to the names of potential witnesses.
- 3. I believe that the interest of each party to a fair trial dictates that Plaintiff's In Limine Motion to Exclude Certain Evidence Of Alleged Conduct should remain under conditional seal until the appropriateness of sealing the document and the release of a redacted version of the In Limine Motion Re Certain Conduct is determined by the Court.
- 4. MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

The procedure for sealing records under California Rules of Court, rule 243.1 et seq. applies only to records that are deemed public. (*Id.*, rule 243.1(a)(2).) Motions and responsive pleadings in criminal cases are, ordinarily, "public" records of the court.

Rule 243.1(d) provides that

The court may order that a record be filed under scal only if it expressly finds facts that establish:

- (1) There exists an overriding interest that overcomes the right of public access to the record;
 - (2) The overriding interest supports scaling the record;
- (3) A substantial probability exists that the overriding interest will be prejudiced if the record is not sealed:
 - (4) The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and
 - (5) No less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding interest.

Rule 243.1(e) provides, in pertinent part:

(1) An order sealing the record must (i) specifically set forth the facts findings that support the findings and (ii) direct the sealing of only those documents and pages, or, if reasonably practicable, portions of those documents and pages, that contain the material that needs to be placed under seal. All other portions of each documents or page must be included in the public file.

Rule 243.2(b) provides, in pertinent part, that "Pending the determination of the motion [of a party to file a record under scal], the lodged record will be conditionally under seal."
