INTERIM ORDER SEALING  
REQUEST FOR ORDER TO  
SHOW CAUSE RE CONTEMPT

Franklin and from the Request for Order to Show Cause and its supporting affidavit that information that hitherto has been sealed is set forth in the Request and its supporting affidavit, disclosure of which may prejudice the right of the parties to a fair trial and the privacy of individuals alleged to be victims in the Indictment, the Court orders as follows:
