Indictment filed April 21, 2004 charging the Defendant with Count 1: 182 P.C., a Felony, Counts 2 through 5: 288(a) P.C., Felonies, Count 6: 664/288(a) P.C., a Felony, Counts 7 through 10: 222 P.C., Felonies, Special Allegations on Counts 2 through 5: 1192.7(c)(6) P.C. and 1203.066(a)(8) P.C.

**The Court made orders re: Continuance**

At 8:30 A.M. in the presence of the Jury with Court, Counsel and Defendant present, trial continued.

Counsel present for the People are Thomas W. Sneddon, Jr., Ronald Zonen and Gordon Auchincloss.

Counsel present for the Defendant are Thomas A. Mesereau, Jr., Robert M. Sanger and Susan Yu.

Investigating officer Steve Robel present for the People.

Examination of Laurence Nimmer as a witness on behalf of the Defendant continued.

In the absence of the Jury with Court, Counsel and Defendant present, trial continued.

Examination of Mark Geragos as a witness on behalf of the Defendant continued.

Attorneys Sanger and Zonen addressed the Court re: waiver of the attorney-client privilege.

The Court orders that there is a partial waiver of the attorney-client privilege to November 2003; that the People shall continue their examination and any claim of the attorney-client privilege shall be asserted in front of the Jury.

In the presence of the Jury with Court, Counsel and Defendant present, trial continued.

Examination of Mark Geragos as a witness on behalf of the Defendant continued.

Attorneys Zonen and Mesereau examined the witness.

At 12:25 P.M. the Court admonished the Jury and ordered a recess until May 23, 2005 at 8:30 A.M.

In the absence of the Jury with Court, Counsel and Defendant present, trial continued.

Attorney Zonen made a motion for production of all e-mails between Brad Miller and Mark Geragos. Attorney Zonen made a further motion for production of any notes and communications in Mark Geragos' files for the period that the time waiver covers between Mark Geragos, the Defendant, Konitzer, Weizner, Amen, Schaffle and Casio. The Court orders that said requested materials shall be produced by the Defense to the People on May 21, 2005 by 5:00 P.M. The Court further orders that materials re: Mark Geragos' other clients shall not be produced.


Attorneys Sanger and Auchincloss addressed the Court re: Vinnie Amen. The Court finds that Vinnie Amen did receive a grant of immunity to talk to the District Attorney in their office; that said immunity is not an immunity to anything that is said in the Courtroom; that the Court does not have the power to grant immunity to Mr. Amen; that Mr. Amen shall not be compelled to answer questions if he claims his Fifth Amendment rights; that before Mr. Amen can testify in front of the Jury, a hearing will be held to determine Mr. Amen's position.


