

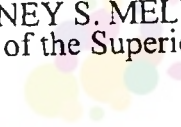
1 By Defense, etc., and may, between the date of this Order and September 16, 2004, release a


