REQUESTING STATE FOR
ATTENDANCE OF OUT-OF-STATE
WITNESS

18 I, RODNEY S. MELVILLE, Judge of the Superior Court of Santa Barbara County, State of
19 California, a Court of Record, do hereby certify:

20 1. That there is now pending, the above-entitled criminal prosecution by the State of
21 California against MICHAEL JOE JACKSON, wherein he stands accused of the following crimes:
22 1 Count of Penal Code section 182 (Conspiracy to Commit Extortion, False Imprisonment and Child
23 Abduction), 4 Counts of Penal Code section 288a (Child Molestation), 1 count of Penal Code section
24 664/288a (Attempted Child Molestation), and four counts of Penal Code section 222 (Furnishing an
25 Intoxicant for Purposes of Committing a Felony).

26 2. That the said defendant is set for a jury trial on January 31, 2005.

27 3. That the said Martin Bashir, now residing at New York City, New York, is a necessary
28 material witness for the People of the State of California for the reason that the witness is material on the

1 issue of the production, editing and displaying of the video documentary "Living with Michael Jackson."
2 The witness is also necessary and material for the reasons stated in the "Request for Attendance of Out-
3 Of-State Witness" filed by Assistant District Attorney Patrick J. McKinley.

4 4. That if the said witness comes into the State of California in obedience to a summons to
5 attend and testify at said jury trial, the laws of the State of California, and of any other state through
6 which said witness may be required to pass by the ordinary course of travel to attend said jury trial, give
7 protection from arrest or the service of process, either civil or criminal, in connection with matters which
8 arose before entrance into said state pursuant to said summons.

9 5. The court hereby orders that as part of this Certificate of Requesting Witness that the
10 witness shall be tendered the statutory fees outlined in section 1134.3 of the California Penal Code and
11 that warrants be ordered issued and drawn from the Auditor of Santa Barbara County in connection with
12 the per diem requirements of \$20.00 for each day that is required to travel to appear as a witness.
